SUBJECT : Appointment to the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board

It is my pleasure to appoint Jeanne Fricot to the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board, subject to your confirmation.

Jeanne Fricot has more than 18 years experience in energy consulting and analysis. She is a Certified Energy Analyst, Certified Energy Plan Examiner and Certified Green Building Professional. Ms. Fricot began her energy career as an Energy Analyst for Sevier Siskowic Engineers, Inc. in 1990, where she prepared Title 24 (California Energy Efficiency Standards for Residential and Nonresidential Buildings) energy compliance reports, assisted engineers with load calculations for mechanical equipment, and performed HVAC and plumbing forensic work. From 1997-2007, Ms. Fricot was an Energy Consultant and HVAC Designer for Haynal & Company, Incorporated. In this role, Ms. Fricot prepared thousands of Title 24 energy compliance reports for residential, commercial, and high performance buildings, and dozens of HVAC designs. Currently, Ms. Fricot is the Owner of Energy & Green Consulting, a firm she established in 2007 specializing in energy modeling and analysis of residential and commercial buildings. She also provides plan check services and evaluates energy efficiency measures to increase energy savings and utility incentives through the Savings By Design program.

Ms. Fricot's professional affiliations include Association of Energy Engineers, Build It Green, California Association of Building Energy Consultants, and U.S. Building Council. She is also a member of the Greater San Diego Business Association.

Ms. Fricot received a Bachelor of Arts degree with Distinction in Industrial Technology from San Diego State University. She is currently pursuing LEED accreditation through the U.S. Green Building Council.

Ms. Fricot's unique energy analysis expertise, experience in identifying energy efficient solutions for residential and commercial buildings, and strong ability to evaluate new

technologies to decrease energy consumption will greatly benefit and support the efforts of the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board.

Ms. Fricot was nominated by Councilmember Todd Gloria, and will serve as an At-Large Alternate for the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board. She will replace Isam Hasenin for a term expiring March 1, 2011. Ms. Fricot resides in Talmadge.
