It is my pleasure to reappoint Jennifer Badgley, Risa Baron, Lisa Bicker and Timothy Golba to the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board, subject to your confirmation.


Jennifer Badgley is an Organizer & Political Director for the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 569. In this role since 2000, Ms. Badgley develops and implements issue-based educational campaigns for members and coordinates local union efforts on construction and development within San Diego and Imperial counties. She also represents workers who build and maintain local renewable energy projects including energy generation facilities, and helps develop workforce readiness to support renewable energy projects in the region.

Risa Baron is an Energy Programs Supervisor for the San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E), and has worked for the utility in various capacities since 1996. As an Energy Programs Supervisor, Ms. Baron designed and currently spearheads SDG&E's energy efficiency local government partnership program featuring conservation, demand response, energy efficiency, and sustainability issues. She also manages the San Diego Energy Resource Center Partnership with the California Center for Sustainable Energy, and serves as a technical resource on various committees and working groups to keep local governments, community organizations, and other agencies informed on sustainable energy issues.

Lisa Bicker is President and Chief Executive Officer of CleanTech San Diego, a non-profit trade organization group focused on accelerating San Diego's position as a world leader in the clean technology economy. With CleanTech since 2008, Ms. Bicker collaborates with a diverse Board of Directors from various industry sectors including academic institutions, biotech businesses, energy corporations, state and local governments, chambers of commerce and non-profit organizations. Ms. Bicker currently chairs the SEAB.

Tim Golba is the founder and CEO of Golba Architecture, a full service architectural design firm for residential, multifamily and commercial projects. The firm has completed hundreds of residential remodels and new construction projects in primarily the beach communities since 1988. Their projects have been featured in such magazines as San Diego Home & Garden and Sunset, among others. Mr. Golba is also a member of the Planning Commission.

Ms. Badgley, Ms. Baron, Ms. Bicker and Mr. Golba are being reappointed to terms expiring March 1, 2012. I ask that you confirm the reappointments and join me in acknowledging these individuals for their willingness to give their time and expertise to serve the City of San Diego in this capacity.
