**SUBJECT:** Appointment to the Utility Undergrounding Advisory Committee

On February 12, 2014 Council approved Resolution R-308721 under Charter Section 43(b) to establish a Utility Undergrounding Advisory Committee to advise the City Council on issues related to utilities undergrounding and the City's implementation of the Utility Undergrounding Program. The committee is composed of fourteen members, with seven nominated by Councilmembers, appointed by the Council President and confirmed by the City Council. On September 24, 2014, I called for nominations to fill a vacancy on the committee per Council Policy 00-13.

It is my pleasure to appoint Don Taylor to fill the vacancy on the Utility Undergrounding Advisory Committee. Don has worked as a member of the Kensington-Talmadge Planning Group's Undergrounding Subcommittee over the last four years and is currently a member of the Kensington-Talmadge Planning Group Board. He has worked with several community members to formally survey Kensington property owners regarding utility undergrounding. He is also currently the President of the Kensington-Normal Heights Friends of the Library. Mr. Taylor was nominated by Councilmember Emerald to fill the vacancy of the community represent the position previously held by Charles Angyal.
