SUBJECT: Appointments and Reappointments to the Wetlands Advisory Board

Mr. Doenges is a senior project manager at J. Whalen and Associates, Inc. where he works closely with the American Corps of Engineers on 404 permits for wetlands impacts and drafts agreements to ensure long-term management of habitat preserves.
