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Dear Members of the City Council,

This letter concerns One Paseo.

I was a real estate partner at Gibson, Dunn & Crutcher in Irvine. I have represented multiple developers and helped develop the entire city of Santa Margarita. I worked for residential builders and developers of shopping centers, office buildings and diverse use projects. I understand, appreciate and support planned development.

But I do not understand your approval of One Paseo. Planned development is just that: you take much into consideration, including traffic, density, and the advice of local planning commissions and the toll the project will place on the infrastructure and its citizens. One also talks to the local citizens, and one also uses common sense.

I have lived in Carmel Valley for over 20 years. I have seen it grow considerably. Its growth seems haphazard, at best. It does not make sense to me that the 56 freeway feeds into the 5 freeway southbound, but not northbound. It makes no sense to me that when Pardee owned so much land, the City did not require, as a condition of development, separate bike paths and walking paths as is the case in Irvine. It makes no sense to me that no public transportation was planned from the very beginning, to be implemented in stages as Carmel Valley grew.

I simply do not understand how a project that obtained approval for a certain amount of footage can bypass all approval committees in place, go directly to the City Council and obtain approval for a project 3-4 times the originally approved size.

I invite you all to drive the various streets in Carmel Valley, particularly Del Mar Heights Road, at peak hours. A drive that used to take me 5 minutes via Del Mar Heights Road to get to the freeway onramp, now takes me 10 to 15 minutes. El Camino Real has taken much of the brunt as people start using it as a way to bypass Del Mar Heights Road. Office buildings in this corridor have greatly impacted the traffic on El Camino and Del Mar Heights Road. We have no tall buildings right on Del Mar Heights Road. This project, as you approved it, simply is too big for the space and is inconsistent with the surrounding area.

I have been told that your approval of this project was "payback" for the Barrio Logan project. I hope that is not the case. I hope you are more mature than that and are not so politicized. We are talking about real people, real lives, and quality of life issues upon which you have an impact. If you lived or worked in Carmel Valley, I can assure you, you would not vote for this project as presented because even if you are pro-development, as am I, you would fully understand the severely negative impact it will have on our neighborhood causing irreparable harm.

I am not against development, as I have stated earlier. But I am against this project as approved by you. But it is not too late for you to rectify that decision.

I request that you rescind your decision. If you are unwilling to rescind your decision, please ensure a fair election by placing it on the June 2016 Primary Election ballot.
