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Dear San Diego City Council,

The importance of the Council's failure to reject the present Paseo One proposal and to force adjustment to fit its neighborhood is more important than the destruction of the community in a few square miles Carmel Valley. The public's acceptance of city government as legitimate decision-making body is at stake.

Governance in a modern democracy depends on leaving the governed with the impression that their collective interests are important to decision makers. The community planning boards are a local resident's collective voice in the planning process. The Carmel Valley, Del Mar Mesa, Torrey Pines and Torrey Hills community planning boards have presented reasoned and fairly obvious arguments why the present Paseo One proposal is inconsistent with the community that the people of north San Diego City and County have planned on as they invested time and money to build the greater Carmel Valley. You these statements and accepted advocacy from the people who seek to make a larger profit by developing something suitable for downtown.
