By ignoring the Carmel Valley, Del Mar Mesa, Torrey Pines and Torrey Hills community planning boards, the City Council sent a message that the feedback from planning groups has a negligible impact on land use decisions, and thus community planning groups have no important role to play in future development of their neighborhoods.
