I live on the west side of the freeway and was the victim of major traffic jams on DMHts. Road and I-56 at 7:30 am and 2:45 pm every weekday for three years as I drove my grandson to classes at CCA. I invite City Council to experience driving that route at those times of the day during the week. District bus service for CCA and TPHS no longer exists--count the enrollment at those schools plus Cathedral High and then consider how many cars are on the arteries that lead to the schools and the impact additional traffic with people still going to work, etc. It is a pipe dream to think that the largely professional population in this area is suddenly going to start working in Carmel Valley when they are well established in other areas. I am not convinced that there will be any advantage in creating "more jobs" with the One Paseo Project.

Additionally, I am very concerned about the impact the extra traffic will have on response times for fire and police responses--both are located on the east side of the freeway and there are already traffic situations that impede their travel time to our area. I pray to God that neither my husband nor I have a heart attack, fall, diabetic coma, or there is a fire in my area--my property is just below an undeveloped area with significant underbrush and dry tinder for a fire.

Having said all of this from a personal view, I also can see with a wider view of the monstrosity that One Paseo as it exists now and how it would destroy the unique character of the Carmel Valley, Torrey Pines, Torrey Hills and Del Mar area. This is not a "not in my backyard" observation, it is a protective responsiveness to the real threat of a radical intrusion into a well established community with people who really care about their lives, schools, homes, businesses, etc. and actively participate in community governing groups to give thoughtful consideration for the needs of this area as a whole. Why are their voices not given due regard?

I urge you, City Council, to reconsider the decision to approve the One Paseo Project and truly represent the citizens who elected you and have informed you that we do not want This One Paseo project as it exists at this time.
