I am gravely concerned about Kilroy Realty's proposed One Paseo project, and I'm writing today to share with you my concerns about the negative impacts this project will bring to Carmel Valley.

I am especially concerned about the impacts to traffic congestion in the area, given that One Paseo will increase traffic by 370 percent and add nearly 24,000 daily car trips to our roads. All of this will lead to gridlock, especially given that the effectiveness of the proposed traffic light synchronization system has not been proven, nor has Caltrans or the City committed to its implementation. In fact, the project's Environmental Impact Report shows significant, unmitigated impacts to eight intersections and road segments. Furthermore, traffic relief near the project site depends on new freeway connectors that will not be built until 2030, if ever.

I wrote to you and the other City Council members earlier regarding my concerns about One Paseo, and wish to reiterate that the current project is not 'right' for our community in Carmel Valley because of it's massive scale and in my opinion, a total ignoring of what our community wants and needs versus what Kilroy wants.

As I was being shuttled from a local Del Mar car repair shop to home, the driver noted the numerous "No One Paseo" yard signs and made the following comment: "I have been getting mail from them on this project and I wish they would stop sending it. I don't understand why my neighborhood is being bombarded with their literature. I don't even live close by and I would not shop there anyway." When asked where he lived, he said "Claremont". CLAREMONT!!!!! Now that got me riled.

So, once again Kilroy is assuming that they have the 'green light' to proceed with this outrageously enormous project before any ground is even broken. How arrogant!!! Are they paying off Council members or other city officials to get what they want, either in dollars or favors? What do they know that the general public does not? Additionally, as I pointed out in my previous letter, why hasn't Kilroy provided a project scaled to the allotted density? The "If I build it, they will come" mentality is just dumb.

In my previous letter, I also shared how I am trapped in my own home due to traffic volume now. Should you and the Council approve this project as it currently stands, I am afraid that I will never be able to do any trips by car unless it is after 8 pm and before 7 am. Mass transit is a brisk three mile walk away - approximately 50-60 minutes- in good weather and hitting the traffic pedestrian lights just right. And, heaven forbid that I should need emergency help, maybe my life could be saved in time if there is not a traffic jam as there most certainly will be if Del Mar Heights Road is widened as planned. New freeway connectors are tentatively scheduled to be built in 2030 - maybe. So how is that supposed to help with traffic congestion? I also don't ride my bike on Del Mar Heights Road anymore due to safety concerns, even with the bike lane and the new three foot passing law.

The simple fact of the matter is that, as proposed, One Paseo is not only too large for Carmel Valley, it's also misplaced in our region. To reiterate, One Paseo has already been rejected by the Carmel Valley, Torrey Pines, Torrey Hills and Del Mar Mesa Community Planning Boards, as well as the San Diego Planning Commission. When the matter comes before the City Council, please reject THIS One Paseo. I know I am certainly against this project and have been since the beginning because it doesn't make any sense for those of us who live here. My property value would decrease; why would I want that to happen?

A park or open space would be a better use of this space than the current project offered. At least I would use it then. I have no desire to frequent the One Paseo development as it currently stands. Why do I want another Horton Plaza in my backyard when UTC is only minutes away? My shopping habits have already been established, and they do not include the current One Paseo development.

Dear Council President Lightner,

I agree with everything stated below, but I have to add a few points. I bought in Carmel Valley so I could commute by bike to my job in Torrey Pines. Getting home is bad enough without the additional traffic. I am also conserned about the additional signals between I5 and El Camino Real. There will be a huge amount of traffic that will cut through my neighborhood on High Bluff. This is the street where my 5 year old daughter walks to school, and my 2 year daughter will walk in 3 years.

The plan calls for 500,000 square feet. The developer bought the land with the assumption that they will be able bully and buy their way into destroying our neighborhood. Once they have crapped it all up, they will be on their merry way counting their dollars, and those of us living in Carmel Valley will be stuck with the consequences.

I am asking you not to let that happen. Stick to the plan.

I am gravely concerned about Kilroy Realty's proposed One Paseo project, and I'm writing today to share with you my concerns about the negative impacts this project will bring to Carmel Valley.

I am especially concerned about the impacts to traffic congestion in the area, given that One Paseo will increase traffic by 370 percent and add nearly 24,000 daily car trips to our roads. All of this will lead to gridlock, especially given that the effectiveness of the proposed traffic light synchronization system has not been proven, nor has Caltrans or the City committed to its implementation. In fact, the project's Environmental Impact Report shows significant, unmitigated impacts to eight intersections and road segments. Furthermore, traffic relief near the project site depends on new freeway connectors that will not be built until 2030, if ever.

The majority of our community believes that THIS One Paseo is too large for the neighborhood. The Carmel Valley, Torrey Pines, Torrey Hills and Del Mar Mesa Community Planning Boards, as well as the San Diego Planning Commission, have already rejected One Paseo. I'm standing with more than 6,000 members of my community to oppose the project and urge you to reject it.

Please don't consign Carmel Valley to a future of extreme congestion and hair-pulling traffic jams. Reject One Paseo and ask Kilroy to work with the community to propose an appropriately sized project.

Dear Council President Lightner,

Development requires several different interconnected elements to truly be considered "smart growth." One Paseo is not smart growth development. Although it has been marketed as smart growth, an honest examination of the project shows that One Paseo is not the type of bikeable, walkable, transit-oriented development San Diego deserves.

One Paseo will add 24,000 new car trips daily on our roads, further deterring residents from biking and walking in the community. Expanding Del Mar Heights Road to nine lanes will mean faster-moving cars and dangerous conditions for both cyclists and pedestrians. The proposed "cycletrack" will offer inadequate protection to those cycling in the area, as it will run for just a few hundred yards on one side of Del Mar Heights Road. Bike San Diego, the group working to transform San Diego into the world's best city for bicycling, has called One Paseo "bad for bicycling."

One Paseo is not planned to have nearby mass transit until 2035, if ever. It is not located near accessible and convenient mass transit options, and is not currently served by mass transit. The truth is that, as proposed, people from Carmel Valley and the surrounding neighborhoods will have to drive to One Paseo. The developer has proposed quadrupling the average daily car trips allowed for the site because this project is a car-centric development.

I'm asking you to please reject One Paseo because it isn't true "smart growth development." We need to promote smart growth in San Diego, but One Paseo perpetuates urban sprawl and congestion in a suburban neighborhood. A smaller project that does not clog our streets, aligns with transit-oriented principles, and truly promotes walking and biking options in our community should be proposed for this site.
