CS-2 *San Diegans for Open Government v. City of San Diego*

This case involves a dispute between the City of San Diego and Successor Agency and the Department of Finance (DOF) arising from the DOF's refusal to authorize the Successor Agency to expend funds from the Real Property Tax Trust Fund to pay for the competition of shoreline improvements along the boat channel running through the site of the former Naval Training Center.
