A Special Run-Off election was held February 11, 2014, for the purpose of submitting candidates for the office of Mayor to the voter of the City of San Diego. The results of the election have been certified by the Registrar of Voters and the City Clerk, City Council is now asked to declare the results as certified by the City Clerk.

CITY CLERK'S RECOMMENDATION:

Finding and determining, pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.0411 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

The total number of votes cast in the Special Run-off Election was 294,491

II

The results of the canvass of the votes cast in the Special Run-off Election held on Tuesday, February 11, 2014, and certified by the City Clerk, are as follows:

(Filling the vacancy in the four-year term previously held by Bob Filner, who resigned, and expiring in December 2016):

KEVIN FAULCONER 153,491 VOTES (52.89%)

DAVID ALVAREZ 136,701 VOTES (47.11%)

Total 290,192 VOTES (100%)

Kevin Faulconer is hereby declared to be elected to the Office of Mayor in the Special Run-off Election, to fill the remainder of the current four-year term.
