* ITEM-S500: Initiation of an Amendment to the Black Mountain Ranch Subarea Plan. (Black Mountain Ranch Community Area. District 5.)

ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Adopt a resolution initiating an Amendment to the Black Mountain Ranch Subarea Plan to consider the removal of Templeton Street, a 2 Lane Collector between Paseo del Sur and Garretson Street, from the street classification network of the Subarea Plan.

COUNCILMEMBER KERSEY'S RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the following resolution:

(R-2015-482)

Initiating the requested Community Plan and General Plan Amendment;

Directing staff to evaluate the following issues as part of the Community Plan Amendment process:

- Impacts to the connectivity for pedestrians, bicyclists, and transit riders;
- Impacts on parallel streets, as well as the broader circulation network; and
- Level of the community's support.

Declaring that this initiation does not constitute an endorsement of the Amendment; however, this action will allow staff analysis to proceed.

RESOLUTIONS:

ITEM-S501: Fiscal Year 2016 Provision of Interim Housing for Homeless Adults in Existing Non-Tent Facilities and Declaration of a Shelter Crisis in the City of San Diego. (District 3.)

ITEM DESCRIPTION:

That the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego approve execution of Agreements for operation and services of the Fiscal Year 2016 Interim Housing and Day Center Facilities for Homeless Adults, with the option to continue funding for up to four additional years depending on funds available, compliance with Grant Agreement requirements, and program performance. That the San Diego City Council approve the recommended siting of the Fiscal Year 2016 Interim Housing Facility for Homeless Adults at the St. Vincent de Paul Village Campus and Day Center Facility. Please refer to staff report for further information.

SAN DIEGO HOUSING COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the following resolution:

(R-2015-489)

Finding and declaring the existence of a shelter crisis in the City of San Diego pursuant to, and in accordance with the provisions of California Government Code Section 8698.2(a)(1), because a significant number of persons in the City are without the ability to obtain shelter, resulting in a threat to their health and safety;

Declaration that this declaration of the existence of a shelter crisis shall continue until terminated by the City Council; specifically, that it shall be applicable to activities that include, but are not limited to the establishment and continued operation of the Interim Housing Program and Day Center Program;

Declaring that the activities described in this resolution, are not a project as defined in California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15378 and, therefore, are not subject to CEQA pursuant to Section 15060 (c)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines;

Authorizing the Mayor, or designee, to execute such documents and to perform such acts as are necessary and appropriate to implement these approvals.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION:

FISCAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The proposed FY 2016 Funding approved by this action is included in the Housing Commission's FY 2016 Proposed Budget, which is planned to be presented to the Housing Authority in June for approval. Approving this action will authorize the Housing Commission to expend \$2,423,757, subject to Housing Authority approval in June of 2015, for the FY 2016 Budget. Please refer to staff report for further information.
