## MEASURES SUBMITTED TO THE VOTE OF VOTERS STATE 66 ELECTED COUNTY ASSESSOR. Amends State Constitution to require an elected county assessor in all counties. Fiscal Impact: This measure would have no direct state or local fiscal YES 160 + O effect. NO 161 🔶 O MURDER PENALTY, increases prison term for second degree murder of certain peace officers performing duties to 25 years to life. Fiscal Impact: Measure will have a relatively minor impact YES 163 🔶 O on state costs and the state's prison population. NO 164 - O BLEGISLATIVE CAMPAIGNS. CONTRIBUTION AND SPENDING LIMITS. Establishes state legislative campaign contribution limits; provides spending limits where state matching funds accepted. Fiscal Impact: Annual revenue loss from tax return designations to Campaign Reform Fund is estimated at \$9 million. YES 167 🔶 🔿 Annual state administrative costs will be about \$1.9 million starting in 1988-89. NO 168 - O 69 AIDS. Declares carrier of AIDS or related virus a contagious condition, subject to reportable disease regulation, guarantine and isolation. Fiscal impact: The measure's cost could vary greatly depending upon its interpretation by health officers and courts. If only current AIDS control measures are continued, there would be no substantial change in costs. If the measure were interpreted to require added disease controls. the costs could range from millions to YES 172 → O hundreds of millions of dollars per year depending on the measures taken. NO: 173 - O WILDLIFE, COASTAL, AND PARK CONSERVATION BOND U INITIATIVE. Authorizes \$776,000,000 general obligation bonds for park, wildlife, coastal and natural land purposes. Fiscal Impact: Assuming all bonds are sold at an interest rate of 7.5 percent and paid off over 20 years, total repayment cost to state would be about YES 176 🗎 \$1.4 billion. Other costs of unknown amounts could result from possible increase in cost of state borrowing and reduced income taxes NO 177 because interest on bonds is tax free.
