## SPECIAL ELECTION COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 February 16, 1993

This election is being held to fill a vacancy in Council District 8. Pursuant to the City Charter, vacancies on the City Council must be filled by special election. The special election must be held within ninety (90) days of the vacancy. The candidate receiving the greatest number of votes in that election shall be deemed to be elected to the vacant office, and shall serve only until the next regular municipal election. In this case, the next regular Municipal Election is scheduled for September 21, 1993, with any run-off election to be held November 2, 1993.
