CITY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE ANNOUNCES MANAGEMENT UPDATES

San Diego, CA: Deputy City Attorney Don Worley has been promoted to lead the City Attorney's Office Civil Litigation Division succeeding Andrew Jones who will take over as head of the Criminal Division.

Mr. Worley began with Seltzer Caplan Wilkins & McMahon in 1970 where he became a partner. He later became a partner in McDonald Riddle Hecht & Worley and then Worley, Schwartz, Garfield & Praire. Over the years he found a specialty in land use litigation, and has trained and supervised some of San Diego's top attorneys. He joined the City Attorney's Office in December as a Deputy City Attorney in the Land Use Litigation Unit.

Mr. Jones currently heads the Civil Litigation Division and will move to take over the reins at the Criminal Division. During his tenure in the City Attorney's Office, Mr. Jones has served as a lead criminal prosecutor, heading the Discovery Unit, and prosecuting abusers in domestic violence and child abuse cases. He has been instrumental in rebuilding the City Attorney's office since the new administration took office in December, 2008.

The current head of the Criminal Division, David Greenberg, took a one year leave of absence from the San Diego District Attorney's Office to join the City Attorney's Office. He will return to the District Attorney's Office in December. The management changes take effect after a transition period that will last about 90 days.

"Mr. Jones, Mr. Worley and Mr. Greenberg are three of the top litigators in San Diego with over 75 years of combined experience. We are fortunate to have them involved in reshaping the City's law firm," said City Attorney Jan Goldsmith.
