### **Councilmember Lightner Announces University City High-Speed Rail Scoping Meeting**

SAN DIEGO --- Councilmember Sherri Lightner announced today that the California High-Speed Rail Authority will hold a public scoping meeting in University City for its San Diego high-speed rail segment. **“I want to ensure all residents have an opportunity to participate in the decision of where any high-speed rail line will go,”** Lightner said.

**Who:** California High-Speed Rail Authority (Contact: Greg Parks, 858-926-4018)

**What:** A scoping meeting to inform and accept comment from the public about proposed routes for a high-speed rail line through the area. The format of the meeting will be a workshop or fair, with displays, staff on hand to answer questions, and handouts, but no scheduled presentations. 3 p.m. - 5 p.m. will be tailored to public agencies, and 5 p.m. - 7 p.m. will be tailored to members of the public, although anyone can come and go at any time.

There will also be two additional meetings held in the San Diego area: Wednesday, October 14<sup>th</sup> from 3 – 7 p.m. at the Ramada Limited San Diego Airport (1403 Rosecrans St., San Diego, CA 92106) and Thursday, October 15<sup>th</sup> from 3 – 7 p.m. at the Escondido Center for the Arts (340 N. Escondido Blvd., Escondido, 92025.)

**When:** Tuesday, October 13<sup>th</sup> from 3 -7 p.m.

**Where:** Lawrence Family Jewish Community Center (4126 Executive Dr, La Jolla, 92037) (at the corner of Executive Dr. and Genesee Ave.)
