SUBJECT: The Impact of the Proposed Medical Marijuana Ordinance on the La Jolla and La Jolla Shores Planned District Ordinances

At the LU&H meeting of March 24, 2010, and the City Council meeting of September 13, 2010, I asked how certain bus stops could be designated as locations subject to the proposed 1,000-foot prohibited zones for dispensaries. In particular, I asked about the inclusion of the bus stop located at the corner of Nautilus Street and La Jolla Boulevard that is used by San Diego Unified School District students but is more than 1,000 feet away from La Jolla High School and Muirlands Middle School.

The addition of this bus stop—and several others used by school-aged children that are similarly located some distance away from schools—need not be made in the La Jolla area if it can be determined that the uses of the La Jolla and La Jolla Shores Planned District Ordinances would not allow the establishment of a dispensary for these locations.
