**Council President Lightner Statement
Regarding One Paseo Returning to Council**

SAN DIEGO --- San Diego City Councilmember Sherri Lightner today issued the following statement in response to the One Paseo Development Project returning to Council for a second hearing.

“I congratulate Protect San Diego’s Neighborhoods on the hard work its leaders performed to educate voters about the importance of this issue and the impact it could have on their neighborhoods,” said San Diego City Council President Sherri Lightner.

“If One Paseo is allowed to stand, it paves the way for massive overdevelopment in San Diego and the destruction of community planning in our city. I hope my Council colleagues will consider rescinding their approval of this project and sending the developers back to work with the community to create a project that minimizes traffic and visual impacts. As I have previously stated, the community wants an appropriate project at this site and is willing to work with the developer. Therefore, I do not feel that the City should spend the time or money sending a community-specific initiative to the ballot when a solution can be found on the community level.”

Per the City Clerk, the second hearing for the One Paseo project will be on Monday, May 18, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. in Golden Hall, San Diego Civic Concourse, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101.
