RECYCLED WATER SHUTDOWN

What: The City of San Diego Water Department must temporarily shut off recycled water flow to customers to perform necessary repairs to the potable water system.

When: **Customers will experience a complete loss of recycled water beginning Friday, April 3, 2009 through Sunday, April 5, 2009. Recycled water service will resume Monday, April 6, 2009.**

The Water Department is recommending that recycled water users sufficiently irrigate their landscaping prior to the recycled water outage. During the outage recycled water service will not be available.

Why: The recycled water system must be temporarily shutdown to ensure the safety of the repair crew accessing the water line which is adjacent to the recycled water pipeline. **Potable water service will continue without interruption.**

More Information: It is very important that all recycled water users are made aware of this information. Please forward notice to all interested parties in your organization.

SUBJECT: Notification of Planned Recycled Water System Shutdown

Recycled water customers in your district will experience a complete recycled water outage beginning Friday, April 3, 2009 through Sunday, April 5, 2009. The outage is scheduled to perform repairs to a potable water main on Miramar Road. The recycled water system must be temporarily shutdown to ensure the safety of the repair crew accessing the water main which is adjacent to the recycled water pipeline. **Potable water service will continue without interruption.**
