After months of input from the community, Council President Pro Tem Kevin Faulconer, the City's Park and Recreation Department and Sunset Cliffs Natural Park Council unveiled the first of numerous one-of-a kind benches specifically built for Sunset Cliffs, a picturesque park overlooking the Pacific Ocean.

Local residents picked the bench design, materials and locations.

Installation began in September 2010 and is scheduled to be completed in phases.

FACTS

- 15 new benches
- 7 of the benches were funded through donations
- 14 benches were built by a City contractor; 1 was donated to the City
- Total cost: Roughly \$45,000
 - Donations: \$17,306
 - Council District 2 Infrastructure Fund: \$20,000
 - City: \$7,766
