Councilmember Gloria Appointed to San Diego River Conservancy

SAN DIEGO, CA (March 18, 2011) – Councilmember Todd Gloria has been appointed to the San Diego River Conservancy by California State Assembly Speaker John A. Perez.

The San Diego River Conservancy is an independent, non-regulatory agency within the Resources Agency of the State of California which was established to preserve, restore and enhance the San Diego River and the surrounding area. Councilmember Gloria is now part of the Conservancy's Governing Board, joining Mayor Jerry Sanders and fellow Councilmember Lorie Zapf, among others.

“The San Diego River is important to the environment, economy and history of our region, and I look forward to ensuring its ongoing viability as a member of the San Diego River Conservancy,” said Councilmember Gloria. **“I am deeply appreciative of Assembly Speaker Perez for appointing me to this new opportunity to serve the community.”**

The term of Councilmember Gloria's appointment is March 15, 2011 through January 1, 2015.

Councilmember Gloria also serves on the Metropolitan Transit System Board, Convention and Visitors Bureau Board, San Diego Consortium Policy Board and on the Public Safety, Transportation and Quality of Life Ad Hoc Committees of the San Diego Association of Governments.
