North Park Clean and Safe District

On May 24, my City Council colleagues approved a resolution of intention to form a Clean and Safe District in North Park. Ballots have been sent out to the affected property owners, who now have 45 days to vote. A public hearing including ballot tabulation is scheduled to be held as part of the City Council meeting on July 12.

Aldine Drive Closure

The long-awaited Aldine Drive Slope Stabilization Project will soon begin. This will result in the installation of a large retaining wall on the south side of Aldine Drive west of Fairmount Avenue.

In order to complete this project safely and efficiently, this section of Aldine Drive is expected to be closed for the duration of construction, which should last approximately six months. I expect Aldine Drive to remain open heading east from Fairmount Avenue toward Talmadge.
