PLANNING FESTIVAL PARK

The City of San Diego, in conjunction with the Jacobs Center for Neighborhood Innovation, invite you to participate in a public workshop for Festival Park at the Village at Market Creek on Thursday, Feb. 16 at 12 noon at Martin Luther King Jr. Recreation Center, 6401 Skyline Dr.

Our community involvement is crucial to ensuring that this pocket park provides plenty of passive recreation opportunities for city residents of all ages. Input from this workshop will help design the General Development Plan for this much-anticipated public park that will be located just south of the amphitheater and cultural village. On Tuesday, Feb. 7 the San Diego City Council approved a \$57,101 contract to install new

playground equipment and rubberized safety surface at the aging tot lot at the popular Dennis V. Allen Park in the Mt. Hope neighborhood of District 4.



Southeast Economic Development Corporation (SEDC) has generously agreed to provide the funds to purchase the

much needed new playground equipment that is scheduled to be installed later this year to replace the existing play elements that are old and in poor condition. The City of San Diego public park originally opened in 1977 and the playground was last improved in 1988. This tot lot upgrade will greatly enhance the local park and encourage more families to gather for events and activities.


