## Myrtle's Message


The **Tubman-Chavez Multicultural Community Center** has been renovated and the grand reopening is on the horizon for early Spring. Neighborhood House Association has been selected as the Master Tenant. Organizations seeking to sub-lease office space must submit proposals to the City of San Diego's Real Estate Assets Department.

## Tubman-Chavez Mural Sign

To prepare for the façade changes, City employees tried to carefully extricate the mural sign from the front of the building. During their efforts, the mural crumbled and could not be salvaged. **The mural sign was full of mold and other hazardous materials which caused it to deteriorate.** It had been falling apart over the past year. The art piece had not received proper maintenance or treatment to preserve, maintain, and extend its life expectancy.

The **good news is - a beautiful mural remains on the east wall of the center.**

We will commission another public art piece for the front of the building when the center is fully occupied by the master tenant and other nonprofit organizations. The tenants and the community will select the final design for installation.


## NEWS | You Can Use

- **The Code Enforcement Section** has issued a Civil Penalty Notice for the non-permitted conversion of a second dwelling unit and other violations of the land development code. These civil penalties may be assessed at a daily rate not-to-exceed \$2,500 per day and a total maximum not-to-exceed \$250,000 per parcel or structure for any related series of violations. **Notice of Abatement Vacant and Unsecured Structure** | This notice was issued for a structure deemed vacant and unsecured which poses a serious threat to the public's health and safety and is declared a public nuisance in accordance with the San Diego Municipal Code. Code enforcement helps to keep our neighborhoods clean and safe.
- Each year the City of San Diego's **Environmental Services Department** conducts special community clean up events in neighborhoods throughout the City. Areas are selected for these events based upon citizen requests, pledges of community involvement and previous citizen participation levels. On March 1, 2014, we conducted **a community cleanup in the Lomita area**. This successful cleanup removed a total of 40.77 tons of waste from the neighborhood.



### District 4 Councilmember Myrtle Cole Will Speak At Malcolm X Library, at 12 Noon on Saturday, April 12, 2014 on Issues Affecting Our District

Myrtle Cole was elected to the San Diego City Council on June 3, 2013. She is the first African-American woman elected to serve in office for the City of San Diego and the first woman to represent the Fourth Council District. Myrtle has worked in the Fourth District since 1977 and has lived in the community of Rolando for more than 28 years.

Myrtle attended the University of Arizona and then joined the Tucson Police Department. She moved to San Diego to continue her career in policing, rising to the rank of lieutenant with the San Diego Community College District Police Department. After 11 years as a police officer, Myrtle pursued and obtained an MBA from National University. Shortly after, Myrtle accepted a position with the San Diego City Council to help implement Community Oriented Policing. This innovative policing approach is still successful today as it strives to work directly with community leaders and residents to identify and prevent crime. Continuing her community advocacy, Myrtle worked with Deputy Mayor George Stevens on affordable housing issues and on a broad array of community issues with Councilmembers Charles Lewis and Tony Young.

Immediately prior to her election, Myrtle worked for the United Domestic Workers (UDW), who provides in-home services to thousands of low-income seniors, children and people living with disabilities. She helped UDW fight for funding to keep the elderly in their homes, provide living with care and to provide good pay and benefits for the home care workers. In 2009 Myrtle received the National Council of Negro Women, Inc. award for her community service and in 2010 the NAACP honored her with the coveted A. Philip Randolph Award for educational leadership that strengthens the African-American community.

Myrtle is widely viewed as the leader on the Council in the fight for increased public safety resources, neighborhood infrastructure and workforce development. She is also a strong advocate for workers' rights and makes neighborhood revitalization her top priority.
