**Civic San Diego Appointment**

On Monday, my council colleagues and I unanimously approved the appointment of Reese Jarrett to lead Civic San Diego. Civic San Diego - formerly Centre City Development Corporation and Southeastern Economic Development Corporation - will play an important role in developing key areas in the Fourth Council District.

I've heard from all of you. We want quality retail and quality jobs. We want to see buildings going up and areas being developed. We want to spend our hard earned dollars in our own communities. I've said it before and I'll say it again - there is a dire need for economic development and neighborhood revitalization in this district.

Our new leader of Civic San Diego, Reese Jarrett, is a native San Diegan with a long history in this community. Part of his responsibility will be to identify new approaches to urban revitalization.

**Former Valencia Park Library**

My council colleagues and I approved the bid and award of the demolition of the dilapidated former Valencia Park Library.

This building has become an eyesore in our community. My office has received several calls about its condition as it is now a public safety issue. As Vice Chair of the Public Safety & Livable Neighborhoods Committee and the Infrastructure Committee, I am working hard to ensure we have clean and safe neighborhoods and solid infrastructure. Every day, I am putting neighborhoods first and getting things done for you.

**Neighborhood Revitalization:**

- Code Enforcement NOTICE OF VIOLATION issued:** This notice was issued for a property on **College Avenue** that is in violation of the San Diego Municipal Code and California Health & Safety Code. The property is operating as a Marijuana Dispensary. The City DOES NOT PERMIT a Marijuana Dispensary to operate within this 600 foot radius of an elementary school.
- Each year the City of San Diego's **Environmental Services Department** conducts special community clean up events in neighborhoods throughout the City. Areas are selected for these events based upon citizen requests, pledges of community involvement and previous citizen participation levels. On September 13, 2014, we conducted **a community cleanup at Chollas Lake**. These successful cleanups removed a total of 19 tons of waste from our communities. The Oak Park Community Council, Redwood Village Community Council, Rolando Community Council, Rolando Park Community Council and Webster Community Council are to be commended for their assistance and support.
