**Trolley Residential Project | Quality Affordable Housing & Quality Jobs**

This week at City Hall, my council colleagues joined me in voting to unanimously approve the staff's recommendation of a proposed \$3,120,000 residual receipts loan to Trolley Residential CIC, L.P. We also voted to take initial steps to issue tax-exempt, multifamily mortgage revenue bonds to facilitate **new construction of the affordable rental housing development** to be located at 4981 Market Street.



This project will be right in the heart of our district and on the second most used transit station in the entire MTS system – only second to the border crossing! It will also be located across from the new Walgreens that will open next month and what will soon be a grocery store, restaurants, and much more!

I am grateful to the Jacobs Center for Neighborhood Innovation (JCNI), a great partner in the community. On the Economic Development Bus Tour we had last month, President & CEO of JCNI Reginald Jones announced that they would have \$45 million in the ground by the end of the year. This fifty-two (52) unit project is an exciting \$23 million investment into quality, transit-oriented affordable housing and quality jobs. I am honored and excited that we approved the staff's recommendation.



- Neighborhood Revitalization through Code Enforcement** | Two CIVIL PENALTY NOTICE AND ORDERS and Two NOTICES OF ABATEMENT VACANT AND UNSECURED STRUCTURES: These notices were issued for **4 different properties** that are ALL in violation of the San Diego Municipal Code. The property located at **347 63<sup>RD</sup> Street** and the property at **5466 Bonita Drive** have accumulated litter, weeds, waste, debris and rubbish that pose a fire and/or health hazard that must be removed. The property at **515-517 63<sup>RD</sup> Street** is operating a store from the residential dwelling. There is an unpermitted sign that reads, "Family Thrift Shop" in the front of house. The homeowners are ordered to correct all violations and cease operation of the store. Finally, the property owners of **6302 Division Street** are violating the law by maintaining two habitable tent structures and non-incident outdoor storage throughout the property. The homeowner has been ordered to cease occupying the tent structures and to remove them from the property. Civil Penalties are assessed at a daily rate not-to-exceed \$2,500 per day per violation and a total maximum of \$250,000 per parcel. **Code enforcement helps to keep our neighborhoods clean and safe.**

Although they are virtually invisible, these particles can be extremely harmful to fish and other wildlife if they reach our creeks, rivers, beaches and bays. San Diego is one of the few cities of its size in the United States that still sweeps residential areas.
