- Provide a safer pathway for children attending Horton Elementary School

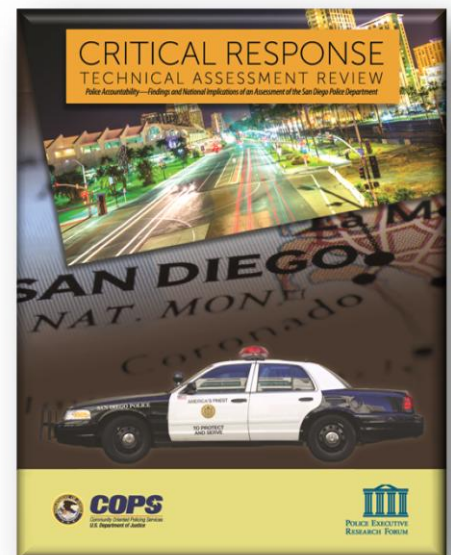

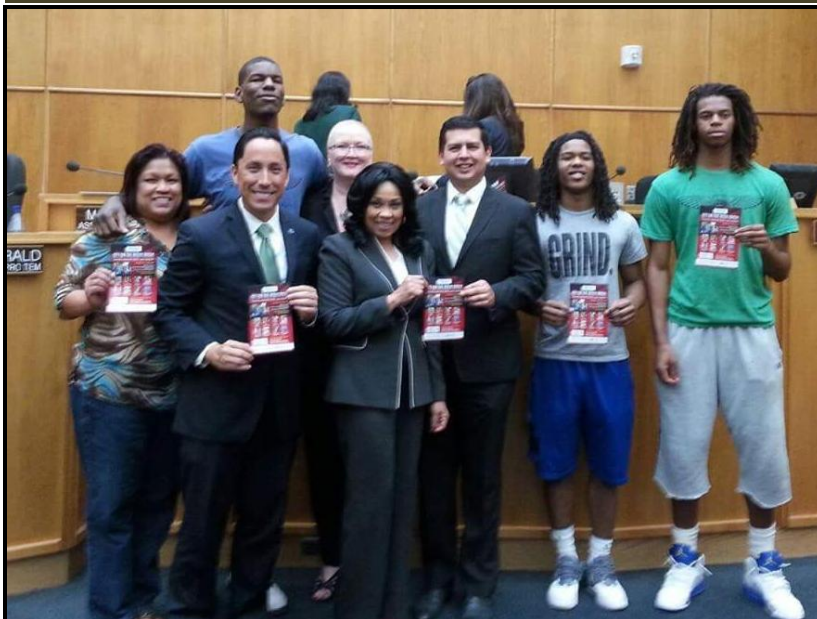
