- **San Diegans Water Usage Drops 24% For June 2015.** In the first month under the State’s 16% water-use reduction requirement, the City of San Diego’s collective water consumption dropped by 24% in the month of June as compared to June of 2013, far exceeding the State mandate.
- **Reporting Graffiti has changed.** Please consider using the new system to document and report any graffiti you see. Urban Corps will still be out removing graffiti throughout the City of San Diego, but only per request from the City and only for private property. The City will be taking care of all public property.
