Recently, I called upon our community to help find the person responsible for the kidnapping of a 9-year-old girl while she was on her way to Valencia Park Elementary School on June 15th.

Thirty-seven-year-old Ieremia Tuiolemoto was arrested on July 7th by Southeastern Division detectives at his home. He is believed responsible in this case and an indecent exposure case on June 9th.

I want to thank the community and commend the excellent work of Captain Tony McElroy and the Police Department's Southeast Division upon the arrest of a suspect believed responsible for this case. Detectives identified the suspect using DNA testing.
