- Wednesday, May 26, 2010* – Joint Budget and Finance Committee/Committee of the Whole considers final modifications to Mayor’s Budget
- Monday, June 14, 2010* – City Council decisions on Final Budget Modifications
- Tuesday, June 15, 2010* – Mayor’s Veto Period Begins
