 5. Resurfacing Requirements (check circumstance that applies). By approval of this Moratorium Waiver, the requester agrees to repair and resurface the street in accordance with the City of San Diego Municipal Code Section <u>§62.1208</u> and <u>§62.1209</u>, and follow required City of San Diego Standard Drawings and specifications. 							
The excavation is in the direction of traffic. The excavator shall resurface the entire excavation area plus the excavation influ- ence area on each end of the excavation area, and the entire width of the street from curb to curb or where a raised median is present the excavator shall resurface from curb line to raised median. The influence area extended around the perimeter of the excavation is inches.							
The excavation is perpendicular to the direction of traffic. The excavator shall resurface the entire length of excavation from curb to curb or for the length of the excavation plus the excavation influence area extending on each end of the excavation, whichever is less. The resurface shall also include the excavation area plus the excavation influence area on each side of the excavation area. The influence area extended around the perimeter of the excavation is inches.							
A raised median is present and the excavation is perpendicular to the direction of traffic. The excavator shall resurface either from the raised median to the curb or for the length of the excavation plus the excavation influence area extending on each end of the excavation, whichever is less. The resurface shall also include the excavation area plus the excavation influence area on each side of the excavation area.
