WHEREAS: It has been brought to our attention that the city of San Diego be enjoined to show cause why it should not prohibit usage of Balboa Park facilities for certain community-wide purposes; and

WHEREAS: We are concerned that any citizens be denied the use and privileges of public park facilities;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That we, San Diego District, California Federation of Women's Clubs, affirm our belief that continued use of park facilities be allowed for the celebration of legal holidays, such as Thanksgiving, Christmas, etc., as the citizens have enjoyed in the past;

That, further, such sponsoring groups should have the same equal opportunity for park use as other groups;

And that such opportunity should be available on the same rental basis.

Passed this ninth day of February, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine in regular meeting assembled.
