Gentlemen:

Gordon M. Dawson Post No. 1877, Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, and its Auxiliary, having a membership of 161 and 110 respectively, respectfully ask to be assigned a meeting place having two halls, so both organizations can continue to meet on the same date and at the same time, as they have in the past 16 years. It is understood that space will soon be available and park buildings will be assigned in the near future.

This post and its Auxiliary have one regular meeting and one social meeting each month, conducted in the evening, and the attendance at regular meetings is between 40 and 60 for each. The social meetings are held in conjunction with the ladies and open to others and the attendance varies from 90 to 150 persons, general depending on the programs presented.

In addition this post and its Auxiliary have regular committee meetings, rehearsals and practices for their officers several times each month, besides card parties, pot luck dinners, re-unions and birth-day celebrations. With the exception of committee meetings and re-hearsals for officers these gatherings are all open and any-one may attend.

It is earnestly requested that this organization be given due consideration when assignments are made of park buildings.
