Returned is document 367055, communication from Gordon M. Dawson Post No. 1877, Veterans of Foreign Wars, requesting assignment of meeting places in Balboa Park.

At a regular meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners November 13, it was the unanimous opinion of the Board that Veterans' organizations will be informed that no building will be assigned for the exclusive use of Veterans' organizations, but that the Park Department hopes to have an auditorium available for meetings of all such groups at a fixed rental fee some time in the future.
