Morley, Park Director, in building up a wonderful park system, could receive due recognition by naming the recreation area in the northeast corner of Balboa Park "MORLEY FIELD", Now, therefore,

"BE IT RESOLVED that the recreation area in Balboa Park along Upas Street from Alabama to Arnold Streets be, and it is hereby officially named "MORLEY FIELD"."
