SUBJECT: Ford Building - Aerospace Museum

The Council referred to the Park and Recreation Board and the City Manager a proposed resolution from the docket of November 18, 1971 concerning the retention of the Ford Building and its occupancy by the Aerospace Museum, and requested a report and affirmative recommendation on the subject from the Board.

This matter was considered by the Board at its meeting held January 19, 1972. The Board made the following recommendations:

- a. That the Master Plan for Balboa Park be amended to permit structures, including the retention of the Ford Building, in the Palisades Area of the park.
- b. That the Ford Building be designated for use by the Aerospace Museum when renovated for occupancy.
- c. That the Council be advised that the Board is now considering other improvements to Balboa Park, and desires to include the project for renovation of the Ford Building in a list of priorities to be submitted to the Council at a later date.

## Cost Estimates

The estimated cost of repairing and changing the Ford Building to allow occupancy by the Aerospace Museum is as follows:

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This estimate is based on the detailed estimate in the report prepared by Paderewski-Dean & Associates, which has been modified to exclude all items of work which are not absolutely essential. The original bond issue estimate totaled \$2,100,000. The reduced estimate deletes the following items of which were included in the original report:
