The American Association for the United Nations, San Diego Chapter, requests approval to use the Organ Pavilion at Balboa Park, without payment of fee, on October 24, 1950.

October 24, 1950 is United Nations Day, and the San Diego Chapter of the American Association for the United Nations intends to hold its second annual picnic in the Organ Pavilion at Balboa Park in order to raise funds for educational purposes.

The proceeds from the public picnic this year will be used by the United Nations Scholarship Committee to help young people in San Diego to visit the United Nations at Lake Success and elsewhere. A number of San Diego groups is cooperating with the second annual picnic of the local Chapter, including the House of Pacific Relations, State College students, churches, and other organizations.

At the second annual picnic of the Association, a multiple-purpose food meal will be served for which a charge of 75 cents per person will be made. A profit of 50 cents will be realized on each meal served, because the food is processed from soybean which is a vegetable protein. Animal proteins as in meat, eggs, etc., are too expensive to afford any such profit per meal.

One thousand meal tickets will be printed for sale and distribution. It is hoped to sell between 400 and 500 tickets, grossing \$300. to \$375. Expenses will be \$100. to \$125. It is expected that \$200. to \$250. will remain for the educational purposes.

The sandwich-salad luncheon will be served at the Pavilion between the hours of 1 P.M. to 2 P.M. and between 4 P.M. and 5 P.M. During the period 2:30 P.M. to 3:30 P.M. an organ concert of international musical selections will be presented by Royal A. Brown, organist for the City of San Diego, who presented the musical entertainment at the picnic last year. During the organ concert, no food will be served.

The American Association for the United Nations is a non-profit organization, and Mrs. Esther Wisdom, 4843 Voltaire Street, San Diego, is President, and Miss Mary Nicolls, 3560 Fourth Avenue, San Diego, is Secretary.

Inasmuch as the second picnic of the American Association for the United Nations, San Diego Chapter, is a fund-raising appeal for a charitable purpose, a public solicitations permit, No. 1256, was issued upon investigation and approval by the City Department of Social Welfare.

In view of the fact that the American Association for the United Nations, San Diego Chapter, is a non-profit organization which contemplates the distribution of total gains or total profits to and for a charitable purpose, and that its second annual picnic to be held on October 24, 1950 is for the purpose of helping young San Diegans to visit the United Nations at Lake Success and elsewhere, distribution free that approval for use of the Organ Pavilion at Balboa Park, without payment of Teo, be granted, as it was for their first annual picnic on August 28, 1949, 1972, 2150

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That permission be, and the same is hereby granted to the American Association for the United Nations to use the organ pavilion in Balboa Park, without charge, for the purpose of raising money by the serving of a meal therein to help educate the youth of San Diego as to the work of the United Nations.
