Gentlemen:

In regular meeting assembled, the Board of Park Commissioners this day directed that your honorable body be requested to place on the ballot for the next election a bond issue in the amount of \$35,000.00, for the purpose of paving Park Boulevard from Russ St. to the south line of the Exposition Grounds in Balboa Park.

Data recently compiled shows that Park Boulevard is one of the most-traveled streets in the City, and it is not possible for this department to maintain it under these conditions unless it be paved.

Your attention is directed particularly to the fact that the new U.S. Naval Hospital is reached by this drive, and being to the east of it, receives all the dust that is stirred up by the traffic. We are advised that this will prove a serious menace to the patients in the hospital.
