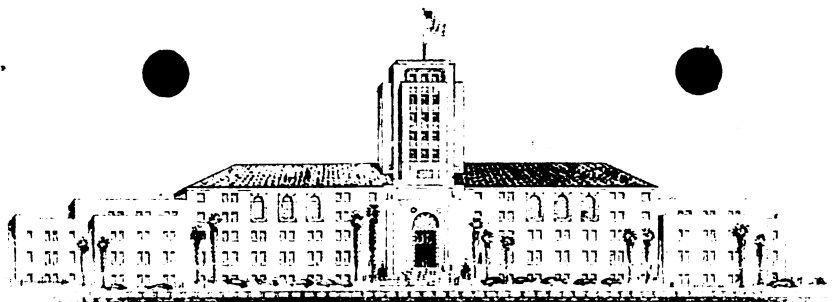

GENTLEMEN:

Returned is document 387 551, communication from Mr. and Mrs. E. L. Truesdale favoring good track for bicycle riding.

The City built a bicycle track in Balboa Park south of the swimming pool, which was used for a little while and finally abandoned. Last summer, the Public Works Department went to considerable expense to recondition the track; and one very nice event was held.

It is felt it is not feasible to build another track until the midget automobile racing track in the stadium is macadamized. When that is accomplished, it will be possible to hold bicycle events in the stadium and have them properly supervised. We cannot macadamize the midget auto track in the stadium until the Balboa stables are removed and an athletic field is constructed on that site.

It is recommended that the communication be filed.
