I have recently learned that the area south and adjacent to the Morley Field tennis courts and swimming pool is to be developed for recreational purposes.

If this is true, I am asking the consideration of the Council in including a facility for distance running in this area. Many individuals in San Diego are interested in distance running. The City Schools include cross country running (two miles in length) in their regular interscholastic athletic program. Surrounding County High Schools likewise include the activity. The local A.A.U. has fostered distance runs. State College and the local service units have placed teams in local events. The factor which has held the activity in check has been the lack of a suitable running course.

A facility of this nature represents a very small outlay of money and the maintenance would be practically nothing. It is my hope that the Council will give consideration to the above request.
