GENTLEMEN:

Returned is Document No. 420516, communication from the Exchange Club of San Diego suggesting the use of a portion of Morley Field, Balboa Park, for flying model aircraft.

Mr. Calland, Director of Parks and Recreation, reports that such activity has been unofficially permitted at times in the Morely Field area, but complaints from residents in the vicinity regarding the noise have made it inadvisable to permit the use of this area for this purpose.

A location has been selected, which is suitable to all parties concerned, on city-owned land north of Montgomery Field. The Public Works Department is now in the process of preparing the ground, and expects to have the job completed by October 31.

The document may now be filed.
