The Park and Recreation Commission was presented the attached report on the history of the Balboa Tennis Club which indicated that approximately 300 persons are active participants on the Balboa Tennis Club courts.

It was further pointed out that the Capital Outlay Program of the City for the next six years calls for the construction of six additional courts at the Morley Field site and that the Master Plan for Balboa Park indicates that the Balboa Tennis Club courts adjacent to Park Boulevard will be removed.

It was the Commission's feeling that arrangements for the use of courts by the Balboa Tennis Club could be developed at a later date.

To the San Diego City Council:

The Tennis players at Mosley Field were very much concerned in learning of the City's plan to destroy the Balboa Tennis Club. As kind of an experiment I hung the enclosed petition on the wall at Mosley and within a week there were the 100 signatures that you see. You will notice that many of the people who signed come from various areas in the County. I think that this is an indication that Mosley Field is the "tennis center" of San Diego and also of the surrounding area. Ten courts are not sufficient and with the Balboa Club members playing at Mosley the situation would become impossible. On week-ends I have often waited for 1 or more hours before getting a chance to play.

Any added consideration that you would give to our cause would be deeply appreciated

To the San Diego City Council:

We, the under-signed, are regular tennis players at Morley Field. The 10 courts are terribly crowded, and it is often necessary to wait from one to two hours before being able to play. Needless to say, this detracts from the joy of playing. We have heard of the Bartholomew Plan to destroy the six Balboa Tennis Club courts across the canyon from us. If this happened, the entire Balboa Tennis Club would flock to the courts at Morley. Even if six courts were added to Morley Field, this would be entirely inadequate to meet the new situation. We ask the Council to consider very seriously the plight of the tennis-playing public of San Diego if the Bartholomew plan is passed without the immediate addition of at least ten more courts at Morley Field.
