

CITY OF SAN DIEGO –CITY CLERK DONATIONS FORM

The City Clerk’s Archives Center would like to invite you all to support our Archives Access and Preservation Project. Your donation will help fund the restoration and preservation of the City’s historical books and documents, which are important to maintaining the rich history of our fine City. Contributions may also be used for the purchase and maintenance of Archives Center equipment, as well as helping to fund archival consultant services.

Donations of any amount are welcome; however, individuals donating \$100 or more will receive a ‘scroll’ (see photo below). The scroll is made of vinyl and features a graphic of the historic Pascoe Map of 1870, along with an excerpt from the Minutes of an 1868 meeting of the Board of Trustees where a City Park (later to become Balboa Park) was created. The scroll measures 26.5” in length by 16.5” in width. Gold-colored cord for easy hanging, and red tassels complete this lovely representation of a significant moment in San Diego’s history. (Note: color of cord and/or tassels may vary due to stock availability). The scroll will come shipped in a mailing tube via U.S. Mail to the address provided below.
