

Community Master Street Tree Plans

Block-by-block blueprints for "Green Streets"

Long, tree-lined streets are memorable. Striving to enhance their streets, many San Diego communities have Master Street Tree Plans. These designate street tree species that are consistent with pre-existing plantings in order to create neighborhood themes. The plans also propose future street tree objectives.

How can we view my neighborhood's Master Street Tree Plan?

These plans may be available through your neighborhood's Community Planning Group, the local library, or the City's Development Services Center, Records Section, 1222 First Avenue, Second Floor, San Diego, CA 92101.

The City has made policy modifications to expand the community forest. Communities can take steps toward broader parkways as well as bigger and more numerous trees by revising their Master Street Tree Plans. This work takes place at the community planning group level, in coordination with the City's Planning Department.
