CLASS SPECIFICATION

SAN DIEGO CITY CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

HEAVY TRUCK DRIVER II

DEFINITION:

Under general supervision, to drive heavy truck/trailer combination vehicles where the trailer towed has a gross vehicle weight of over 6,000 lbs; to assist in loading and unloading trucks; to perform construction and maintenance work; and to perform related work.

* EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Drives a truck and trailer combination engaged in hauling materials and supplies;
- Spreads gravel and materials on roads;
- Dumps and loads;
- Picks up and delivers supplies and personnel as directed;
- Patches roads, cleans culverts, performs minor concrete patching and other routine unskilled manual tasks;
- Does minor servicing and maintenance on assigned equipment;
- May operate a two-way radio;
- Completes mileage and Driver's Inspection Reports.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Please note: the minimum qualifications stated below are a guide for determining the education, training, experience, special skills, and/or license which may be required for employment in the class. These are re-evaluated each time the position is opened for recruitment. Please refer to the most recent Job Announcement for updated minimum qualifications.

Six months of experience as a Heavy Truck Driver I with the City of San Diego; **OR** six months of experience operating vehicles requiring a Class A or Class B California Driver's license; **OR** six months of experience operating construction equipment such as loaders, graders, bulldozers, backhoes and other similar heavy equipment. Possession of a valid California Class A Driver's License.
