SAN DIEGO CITY CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

JUNIOR ENGINEER - ELECTRICAL

DEFINITION:

Under immediate supervision and in a training capacity, to perform increasingly responsible professional level electrical or electronic engineering work; to check less complex plans for electrical or electronic design; and to perform related work.

* EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Inspects electrical contract work to ensure compliance with plans and specifications;
- Does electrical or electronic design work on lighting, communications, and signal systems;
- Prepares sketches, layouts, material lists, and cost estimates;
- Checks construction plans for conformance to contract requirements;
- Checks less complex building plans for conformance to applicable electrical regulations and calculates electrical adequacy;
- Prepares reports.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Please note: the minimum qualifications stated below are a guide for determining the education, training, experience, special skills, and/or license which may be required for employment in the class. These are re-evaluated each time the position is opened for recruitment. Please refer to the most recent Job Announcement for updated minimum qualifications.

A Bachelor's degree in Electrical Engineering, Electronics, or a closely related engineering field; **OR** registration as a professional Electrical Engineer with a State Licensing Board; **OR** possession of an Engineer-in-Training certificate issued by a State Licensing Board.
