WORK SERVICE AIDE

DEFINITION:

Under immediate supervision, to perform a variety of entry-level, unskilled tasks in various City Departments; and to perform related work.

*** EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:**

- Washes trucks and cars;
- Paints playground equipment;
- Stuffs envelopes for mass mailing;
- Runs errands and picks up supplies;
- Sorts and discards obsolete material;
- Cleans areas of debris and litter;
- Sets up chairs, tables and equipment;
- Sweeps and mops floors.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:
