Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) - 2009-2012

Notice of Availability of Funds

The City of San Diego anticipates receiving approximately \$12.5 million from the U.S. Department of Energy for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant.

The City of San Diego has formed an Ad Hoc Committee to review the potential uses of the EECBG funds. Individuals with ideas may present them to the Ad Hoc Committee by filing a completed copy of a "Project Activity Worksheet." Only projects for a minimum amount of \$250,000 will be considered.
