**ONE-DAY DELAY IN TRASH AND RECYCLABLES COLLECTION  
FOLLOWING THE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. HOLIDAY**

**San Diego, CA**--The City of San Diego's Environmental Services Department reminds City residents that refuse normally collected Monday, January 15, will be picked up one day later due to observance of the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday. Trash will be taken one day later for the remainder of the week (Tuesday's refuse will be picked up Wednesday, etc. and Friday's trash will be collected Saturday). Collection of trash and recyclables will return to a normal schedule beginning Monday, January 22.

The City's Miramar Landfill will be open slightly shortened hours on the holiday, from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The Landfill will return to its normal operating schedule, from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., on Tuesday, January 16.

This holiday service information is for the City of San Diego only. Residents in other cities should check with their waste hauler for holiday service schedules.
