## **SPECIAL TRASH, RECYCLING AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION ON SATURDAY**

### **Refuse Collection**

- The City of San Diego Environmental Services Department will provide a special trash, recycling and yard waste collection on Saturday, October 27 for those routes normally collected on Tuesday, October 23.
- All areas normally serviced on Tuesday will be collected on Saturday. However, any areas not cleared for repopulation by Saturday will not be collected.
- Areas normally collected on Tuesday will return to a normal schedule on Tuesday, October 30.
- The special collection will include recycling or yard waste pickup if normally collected on Tuesday.
- Areas not collected on Tuesday include Mira Mesa, Rancho Bernardo, Rancho Penasquitos, Scripps Ranch, Mission Bay, Sabre Springs, and parts of Carmel Valley, Carmel Highlands, and Carmel Mountain Ranch.
- Tuesday's collection did not occur because trash trucks could not enter areas affected by the fire. In the non-burn areas, many containers were not set out for collection.
- Trash, recycling and yard waste collection services for the rest of the City will continue on its regular schedule.
- Residents who lost collection containers in the fire and need to request new ones, or for other information, call the Environmental Service Department customer service at 858-694-7000.

### **Miramar Landfill:**

- The City's Miramar Landfill continues to operate on its regular schedule.
